She also provided the following updates:

Education: The leadership team is focused on summer school, addressing the School Review feedback, the plan for Summer Institute, and the first weeks of school. The priorities are stamping the Rise school design, naming clear education goals, and working on coaching and the use of data to drive outcomes.

Finance: The leadership team is focused on onboarding the new Director of Finance and federal grant applications. Priorities are naming financial goals and improving quality controls and the budgeting/planning process and approving the annual budget for 2021-2022.

Enrollment: RISE is overenrolled in Kindergarten and 2^{nd} grade and still accepting students for 4^{th} and 5^{th} grades. Student attrition was less than expected.

Talent: There is programming in place for leadership engagement and support. Leadership is filling all staff vacancies and working to develop processes for effective evaluation with opportunities for growth.

Finance Update:

Dawn Arthur presented the draft budget for review, comment, and discussion during her Executive Director's update.

Action item:

A motion was made by Crawford Crenshaw to approve the draft budget as presented. It was seconded by Willette Morman and unanimously approved.
